

CREATOR'S NOTE

In February 2012, my friend Jeso emailed me a Youtube link to Michelle Sutlovich performing "Fame" in a fringed onesie on rust-colored carpet between two artificial plants. It was a scene from the '80s public access TV show, *Stairway to Stardom*. Watching one clip from the show was like a gateway drug. I clicked on another and another. The performers were mesmerizing.

Described by National Public Radio as "an amateur talent show... a low-rent precursor to American Idol," Stairway to Stardom was filmed "in what appeared to be a freshly carpeted Staten Island basement." Host Frank Masi would bring on amateur singers, dancers, actors, and comedians to show off their talents. The drive and emotion behind the performers' eyes was palpable and stuck with me. In 2014, I wrote a proposal for the HERE Artist Residency Program to make a piece inspired by that TV show. I conducted hundreds of hours of interviews with all kinds of people about their dreams, talents, hopes and regrets and began transforming that content into a script, interspersed with stories of my own life experiences. During the three years of my residency at HERE, my intrepid company of women, my gifted team of collaborators and I have developed this work together. The result is not a piece about the TV show or the people that performed on it decades ago, Stairway to Stardom is a piece about us - you and me and everyone in this room and not in this room, right now.

ABOUT THE CREATOR

Amanda Szeglowski (Writer, Director, Choreographer, Performer Artistic Director of cakeface) is a writer, director, choreographer and performing artist. She is a HERE Resident Artist and a recipient of the Virginia B. Toulmin Foundation's Women Playwrights Commissioning program. Formerly a Company Dancer with the internationally acclaimed Ellis Wood Dance (NYC) over a span of four years, she performed with the company throughout New York and on tour in locations such as Portugal, Germany, San Diego and Washington DC, and set work/taught at UC Berkeley and New York University, among others, all while also serving as the company's Managing Director. Amanda launched her all-female company cakeface in 2008. As *Culturebot* describes, "cakeface is a group of fierce, funny, talented women," and later offered, "Think Monica Bill Barnes for the Amy Schumer Generation," in the *Culturebot*

With cakeface, Amanda has guest lectured at the University of South Florida, and taught master classes at the University of Tampa, Hillsborough Community College and Howard W. Blake School for the Arts.

Aviva Novick (Set Design) Aviva Novick is based in New York with interdisciplinary interests, pursuing work that extends into the realms of architecture, set design, industrial design, fine arts, and imaginary architecture. Aviva holds a BA in Fine Arts and a Masters in Architecture. She has collaborated with artists, acrobats, dancers, musicians, as well as other architects, and is passionate about the power of the built environment to move, transform, and reconfigure our perception of reality. Notable projects include: Scenic design for Amerishowz: Circle of Champions (American Realness 2017) and g1br33l (Gibney Dance Center, Double Plus Series 2014), the restoration of a 110 year old historical landmark hotel in the Manhattan's Garment District; the restoration of the Williamsburg Savings Bank in Brooklyn; furniture and interior design for all 3 Valley Nails locations in NYC, "jet blue Ring" at JFK Airport, and the Sony Wonder Technology Lab; a floating bookstore for the Armory Show in 2007 with Vito Acconci, and a one-of-a-kind, transportable aerial acrobatics apparatus for Circus Warehouse in Queens.

Amanda K. Ringger (Lighting Design) has lived in New York since 1997, designing locally, nationally, and internationally with artists such as Faye Driscoll, Doug Elkins, Cynthia Oliver, Jennifer Archibald, Antonio Ramos, LMnO3, Alexandra Beller, Deborah Lohse, Donnell Oakley, Molly Poerstel, Kota Yamazaki, Nora Chipaumire, Laura Peterson, Julian Barnett, 10 Hairy Legs, Tiffany Mills, Darrah Carr, and cakeface, among others. She received a BA from Goucher College in Baltimore, MD and an MFA in Lighting Design from Tisch School of the Arts at NYU. She is the recipient of a 2009 "Bessie" Award for her collaboration on Faye Driscoll's 837 Venice Boulevard at HERE.

Brian Wenner (Composition, Sound Design, Live Mixing) is a New York City-based composer, sound designer, and audio engineer. His work as the musical half of Prism House relies heavily on the manipulation of found sound recordings, analog synthesizers, and Internet-sampled content. The result is a collage composition style that feels both controlled yet chaotic, as well as danceable and rhythmically diverse. His most recent work was a commissioned multichannel installation piece that debuted at Westwood Gallery in Manhattan in May of 2017 for the KAZ Shirane show "Evolve." He also recently completed a full-length album of ambient compositions entitled "Momentum" coming out in September 2017. His work has been covered by outlets such as The FADER, The Creator's Project, VICE, and XLR8R. He performs regularly in NYC and has toured throughout a large portion of the United States.

Matt O'Hare (Live Video Mixing) is a digital artist and performer based in and around New York City. Recent projects include creating tour visuals for the band 311, the sci-fi doom cult spectacle We The New Community, and his latest work The Cure For All Disease, which is basically a Satanic mass with interactive sound and video.
