

DONOVAN & CALDERÓN have been in collaboration since 2003. Previous works include *Not Unclear* at New York University (2003); *Sublimate* at the Galapagos Art Space (2006); their improvisational film *Copy/Edit* (2007), *Se Vende* at the FAE Festival in Panama (2008); the climate chronicles at Incubator Arts Project; 18 ½ Minutes at JACK (2013). They have been Resident Artists at HERE since 2014.

# PRODUCTION TEAM

Sebastián Calderón Bentin (Creator, Director) is a New York-based scholar and performance-maker. He has been in collaboration with Sean Donovan for the past 13 years. Their work has been presented at JACK, Incubator Arts Project, FAE Festival in Panama, Stanford University, and New York University, Sebastián has performed with the International Contemporary Ensemble, Anna Deavere Smith, John Jesurun, Witness Relocation, Ann Carlson, Faye Driscoll, Gisela Cardenas, and the Institute of Failure led by Tim Etchells and Matthew Goulish. As part of PERFORMA 07, he appeared in Allan Kaprow's 18 Happenings in 6 Parts (Re-doing) directed by André Lepecki at Deitch Studios which won Best Performance by the International Association of Art Critics/USA. He performs regularly with the Chicagobased theater company Every House Has a Door including most recently The Three Matadors (2017), 9 Beginnings: Chicago (2014), and 9 Beginnings: Bristol (2014, 2012). Sebastián received a BFA in Theater and an MA in Performance Studies from the Tisch School of the Arts/NYU. He holds a PhD from the Department of Theater and Performance Studies at Stanford University and currently teaches in the Department of Drama at New York University.

Sean Donovan (Creator, Director, Performer) is a New York-based actor, dancer, writer, and director. He has been in collaboration with Sebastián Calderón Bentin for the past 13 years. Their work has been presented at JACK, Incubator Arts Project, FAE Festival in Panama, Stanford University, and New York University. Sean was nominated for a 2014 "Bessie" Award for Outstanding Performer for his work with several artists over the past decade. He's worked with Faye Driscoll, Miguel Gutierrez, Jane Comfort, The Builders Association, Witness Relocation, Jennie Marytai Liu, and others. In New York, he has performed at such places as BAM, The Kitchen, Danspace Project, PS122, HERE, The Joyce Theater, The Duke, The Baryshnikov Arts Center, Incubator Arts Project, NYLA, La MaMa E.T.C., The Chocolate Factory, and others. Recent credits include Thank You for Coming: PLAY at BAM Fisher, Thank You For Coming: Attendance at Danspace Project, and an international tour, Age & Beauty Part 2 at NYLA, and House/Divided at BAM (NY) along with a national tour. He received his BFA in Theatre from New York University's Experimental Theatre Wing. He has trained and performed internationally in France, Holland, Romania, Poland, Russia, Panama, Argentina, Croatia, Canada, Thailand, and Japan working with the highly acclaimed Ildi! Eldi of France, and Sankai Juku Butoh company of Japan. He has also performed at theaters and universities throughout the U.S.

He aims to face the absurd political realities of the United States, his home, head-on and unbowed. Having recently returned to New York from Mass MoCA where he was an Artist in Residence, he is thrilled to be collaborating with such talented artists to create *The Reception*.
