

CO/LAB Theater Group is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing Creative Opportunities without Limits And Boundaries. CO/LAB offers individuals with developmental disabilities a creative and social outlet through theater arts.

CO/LAB held its first class in the fall of 2011 with just 13 actors. Since then, we have developed a comprehensive theater program featuring

weekly CO/LAB:core classes and a robust outreach program through our CO/LAB:connect workshops and residencies. Our team has worked with actors in all five boroughs and several cities outside New York, created dozens of original shows, and provided creative opportunities to over 1,500 actors with developmental disabilities.



Through our programming, we encourage actors to collaborate as an ensemble and discover their individual voices. CO/LAB creates a safe, judgment-free, and neurodiverse environment that allows participants the opportunity to express themselves both in class and on stage. We seek to honor and celebrate every individual.



All of our CO/LAB:core weekly classes are offered at no cost to participants. We aim to provide access to all, regardless of financial background.
